Is there a question for which you are currently seeking God for an answer?

Could the answers that God provides for His people be helpful for you as you seek Him about that issue?

Why not start by prayerfully reading through Zechariah 7-8. By “prayerfully” I mean, before you start ask God to give you eyes to see and a heart to understand what He may want to say to you.

As you read do not worry or be anxious about sections that seem confusing or are difficult to understand. Focus first on the segments and truths that you do understand. This is God speaking to you. Sometimes it helps to read the passage more than once and to make notes as you read.

Here are the four responses we talked about on Sunday. Can they be applied to your question or concern?

**1. Is God the priority?**

**2. Have you considered what it means to love/serve others in this area?**

**3. Are you pursuing the presence of God or a particular blessing or outcome?**

**4. His promise is that one day this will be an area of joy and celebration. Thank Him for that promise!**
